DT Research and Xperience Kick Start the European Under-19 Football Championships

Irish Football Association Members Use WebDT Mobile Tablets to Publish Real-time Game Reports, Stats and Team News

SAN JOSE CALIF., and LONDON – December 15, 2008 - DT Research™, Inc., an industry leader in the development of information appliances for vertical markets, and Xperience, a leading UK Information Technology systems integrator, today announced that the Irish Football Association (IFA) members use WebDT Mobile Tablets to immediately connect with national teams, officials, sponsors and the media during events such as the European Under-19 Football Championships in Northern Ireland. The WebDT Mobile Tablets enable IFA members to share information across multiple locations and publish real-time game reports, statistics and team news. Since the IFA began using the WebDT mobile tablets, they have increased staff productivity by up to 20 percent.

The IFA was chosen by the Union of European Football (UEFA), to host the European Under-19 Football Championships in Northern Ireland in 2005. Considering the large size of the event, the IFA quickly realized that it needed a durable mobile solution that could support all of the tournament's information sharing activities. The IFA's existing IT infrastructure, which was composed of desktop personal computers, did not provide the mobility and wireless connectivity required to provide efficient service to fans, officials, the media and staff at multiple sporting locations throughout Northern Ireland.

DT Research and Xperience worked with the IFA to deploy WebDT Mobile Tablets, providing wireless connectivity to link national teams, officials, sponsors and members of the press.
